Refinishing the Roller

With the exclusive **RetroFinishing process**, we can restore the original roller performance characteristics for one third the cost of new rollers. The process does not require any roller lineup speed changes or process alterations. Restoration takes just a few weeks, with faster turnaround service available. The restoration process is so precise—only 0.004" on diameter or less is removed—that the roller continues to conform to OEM specifications.

When surface damage dictates a more extensive repair, we may recommend re-cutting the rollers. This requires that the entire set of rollers be processed at the same time.

When you are having your rollers restored, be certain that they are equipped with the lifetime **FORDLOC end caps**, guaranteed not to come loose. They can be added to any manufacturer's roller as part of the restoration. It's a George Ford & Sons exclusive.
